Dear Parents/Guardians,

This term we are focussing on developing our understanding of where resources come from and how much is involved in getting them processed. An excursion to **The Farmyard Nursery** has been planned for **Friday 19 May.** We will be travelling to and from the venue by bus.

At The Farmyard Nursery we will have an opportunity to:

- See and meet a variety of different farm animals (includes patting animals);
- Learn the names of each animal family group;
- Discover where products such as milk, eggs and wool come from;
- Learn what products each animal produces;
- Peek into the hen house;
- See the tractor and other farm equipment; and much more.

Below is important information about the day itself.

Date: Friday 19 May 2017

Time: Children will arrive to school as normal. The bus will depart at 9:45am for the short five-

minute trip to the farm. Our session is from 10:00-12:00pm. Children will return to school

by 12:30pm.

What to wear: Children are to wear their sports uniform and be wearing enclosed shoes.

What to bring: Recess and drink in either a lunch-box or a clearly labelled plastic bag; school hat.

Cost: There is no cost to parents as the excursion will come out of the excursion levy.

Supervision: 5 members of staff will be attending. Children will be grouped with an adult and wear a

name tag on the day.
